Arts Elective (1.5 Credit)	<i>Credits are calculated based on a combination of the required Survey of Aesthetics course and other electives offered, part of which must be taken during the rhetoric years.</i> Survey of Aesthetics (0.5) Electives include Concert Choir, Mock Trial, Yearbook w/Graphic Design, Art, and summer Drama Troupe
