Rhetoric School Curriculum Overview

Tenth Grade

We learn, not for school, but for life. Great books, great discussions, and great ideas are the best teachers of history, philosophy, science, and theology. Tenth grade continues their rigorous course work to prepare students for success in any field after graduation. Student presentations and research take center stage as rhetoric students complete a thesis project, training the skills needed for a lifetime of learning.

Eleventh grade

Our rhetoric students continue in the great books, discovering and discussing the impact on topics such as the Reformation, Rousseau, and the Romantics. Students will study Apologetics and Worldview, developing a framework for defending the Christian faith and understanding the worldviews of others. Mathematics courses will be determined by student interest and goals post-high school. The challenge of lab-reports in Chemistry will prepare students for the world of technical/lab writing while the junior thesis prepares them to articulate a thesis statement and defend it.

Twelfth grade

Our students' final year concentrates on great books of modernity in literature, history and philosophy, the purpose of the Church and the completion, presentation and defense of a senior thesis. Students have the opportunity to select a course of science and math for advanced study; one that will position them well for their next steps post-graduation.
