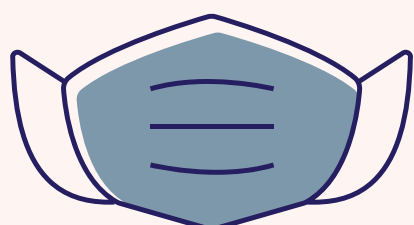


COVENANT ACADEMY COVID-19 PROTOCOL FOR 2021-2022

Mask expectations and frequently asked questions



MASK WEARING STATUS

Covenant's mask expectations will be communicated in the following ways:



OPTIONAL

Current case numbers for the school are low, masks are optional.



RECOMMENDED

Current case numbers for the school are rising, masks are recommended.



REQUIRED

Current case numbers are very high, spreading is observed, masks are required.



KEEP SICK STUDENTS AT HOME

Do not send students to school who are taking medication to control their temperature. Do not send students to school if they have a cough, severe allergies, runny nose, etc.



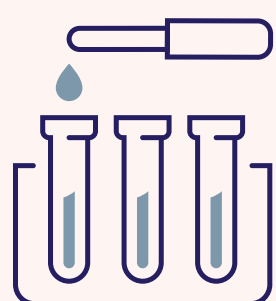
WHAT DO I DO IF I'M POSITIVE?

Contact the school right away. Quarantine. Focus on resting and recovering. The work will get made up when you are able. Don't stress about that. Focus on getting better. Students in grades 7-12 can Zoom as directed by Mrs. Blake. Students in PK-6 do not tend to benefit from virtual instruction, though it can help abate loneliness. A check-in time to see friends can be arranged with your child's teacher.



HOW LONG DO I QUARANTINE IF SICK OR EXPOSED?

For the protection of others, you must quarantine for 10 days and remain symptom free before returning if you are unvaccinated.



SHOULD I GET A TEST IF I'M DIRECTLY EXPOSED?

Yes, but you must also wait 2 days and remain symptom free. If you travel, you may be asked to get a test before returning to school or wait 7 days before returning.

KNOW THE COVID-19 SYMPTOMS

The following symptoms may appear 2-14 days after exposure:

~Fever ~Cough ~Shortness of Breath

Seek medical advice if you experience worsening symptoms.
