Student Council Guiding Principles

Every decision made by Covenant Academy's Student Council should uphold, protect, and reflect the following school values.

- Christ-honoring
- Community-building
- Growing in wisdom and virtue

When a particular Student Council decision calls into question these values, the Student Council should consider the following questions when making that decision. (Please note that not all questions may apply.)

1) Christ-honoring

- Will the person and name of Christ be honored and glorified through this decision? How so?
- Will the decision invite an opportunity to sin?
- Does this decision move us toward godliness?

2) Community-building

- Will this decision strengthen the Covenant community?
- Does it promote inclusivity or exclusivity?
- Will this decision place people in uncomfortable or awkward situations unnecessarily?
- Who will be responsible for the promotion and execution of the event?
- Does this decision ask too much of specific individuals?

3) Growing in wisdom and virtue

- Will the decision promote biblical thinking and biblical living among those involved?
- Does the decision lead its participants to reflect and participate in something substantial and/or life-giving? (I.e. good fellowship? A good meal? Good movie? Rich entertainment?)
- Does this decision honor the parent's authority in the home as well as Covenant's authority as a school?

Nota bene: Director of Student Life and/or Head of School has the authority to overturn any Student Council decision if he/she believes it to be inconsistent with Covenant's values.
